In my therapeutic practice and in my presentations and workshops, I blend both my personal and professional experiences of loss and grief. As a therapist, when I work with an individual or a couple who have endured the death of a child, I help them prepare for the rocks in the waters they will have to navigate, both as individuals, as couples, as parents and as a family. I explore with them the solutions that they think will work for them, and I give them suggestions of what worked for me and for the many other couples I helped through many crises.
